Dear Costco Member,

Costco records indicate that you, or one of your add-on members, have purchased a French door refrigerator from GE Appliances with a model number listed in the chart below. The refrigerators were manufactured between February 2020 and July 2021 and sold in the U.S. under the GE brand name. As part of our commitment to product safety, GEA is offering to provide a free in-home repair. Please read this notice carefully.



GE Appliances, a Haier company (GEA), in cooperation with the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC), has announced a voluntary recall of these freestanding bottom freezer refrigerators with fingerprint resistant stainless-steel coating. The recall is due to the risk that the freezer handle can detach when a consumer tries to open the freezer drawer. If a handle detaches while a consumer is using it to open the freezer, it may cause a consumer to lose their balance, creating a fall risk.

Only refrigerators with one of the model numbers in the below chart and with a serial number that starts with one of the following two letter combinations: DR, FR, GR, HR, LR, MR, RR, SR, TR, VR, ZR, AS, DS, FS, GS, HS, LS, MS are included in this recall. Consumers should locate the model and serial numbers on the product's rating label before contacting GEA.
