



Bow

What You'll Need:

Kirkland Signature™ Wire-Edged Ribbon
Light gauge craft wire
Sharp scissors
Wire cutter

Instructions:

1. Measure 18 feet of ribbon, then cut.
2. Cut gauge craft wire into two 10" pieces.
3. Wrap the ribbon over itself to form the center of the bow.
4. Secure the center of the ribbon with the wire by twisting.
5. Form the size of the bow by folding the ribbon back over itself to the center point, pinch and hold. This creates the first loop.
6. Alternately repeat larger loops on each side of the center loop, about 3 to 4 on each side.
7. Run the wire through the center loop. Pull back around the back of the bow, securing all loops by twisting the wire tightly.
8. Use wire ends to secure the wreath.
9. Cut the tail of the bow at 18". Use the excess to form two additional tails, each the same size to create four tails.

Bottom of bow:

1. Take a tail and fold it in half, bring the tail up the front and over the bow through the center loop of the ribbon. Pull tight.
2. Repeat with remaining tail.
3. Fold the bottom of each tail in half lengthwise, 1" to 2", and cut up at a 45-degree angle to form a "v."

Traditional Elegant Wreath

What You'll Need:

Wreath

Bow

Ornaments (red and gold snowflakes and ornaments)

Lindt Lindor Chocolates

Snowflakes

Instructions:

1. Find the flattest part of wreath to secure the wire ribbon bow.
2. Thread wire ribbon tail through the wreath, or leave out and relaxed.
3. Add ornaments throughout.
4. Fill in with chocolates.
5. Tuck in the snowflakes.

What You'll Need:

Bow
Wreath
Curling ribbon, cut into 10" to 12" pieces
Lindt Lindor Chocolates
Ornaments, variety
Candy canes
Snowflakes

Instructions:

1. Secure wire ribbon bow to wreath.
2. Tie curling ribbon around chocolates. Secure onto wreath.
3. Add ornaments and candy canes.
4. Place in the snowflakes.

What You'll Need:

Curling ribbon, cut into 10" to 12" pieces

Bow

Ornaments, variety

Wreath

Hasbro Troll toys
